

Use LED BULBS - they use the least power and last the longest

- Warm or Soft color (3000 Kelvins or less) healthier, attract fewer bugs
- Dimmable bulbs give you more options

A. Dimmer - use more or less light, as needed

B. Timer - turn on/off at the times you set (digital or mechanical) - turn on for a period of time when motion is sensed C. Motion sensor

D. Dusk-to-dawn sensor - automatically dim or turn on/off, based on level of daylight

- connected to WiFi, use app to turn on/off or program E. Smart bulb


