- **Warm or Soft** color (3000 Kelvins or less) - healthier, attract fewer bugs
- Dimmable bulbs give you more options

Consider these CONTROLS

- | | |
|------------------------|--|
| A. Dimmer | - use more or less light, as needed |
| B. Timer | - turn on/off at the times you set (digital or mechanical) |
| C. Motion sensor | - turn on for a period of time when motion is sensed |
| D. Dusk-to-dawn sensor | - automatically dim or turn on/off, based on level of daylight |
| E. Smart bulb | - connected to WiFi, use app to turn on/off or program |
